Staff prepared a draft budget for FY 2021-2022, similar in most respects to the previous four years, with the exception of a \$10,000 decrease in anticipated Bay Area UASI Administration Grant, for the Board's review and approval. Expecting increase in insurance premium/cost in upcoming fiscal year. Director Marc Roberts motioned to approve the budget, seconded by Director Nick Luby. Motion carried with a vote of 10-0.
